6/09 Members' Community Reports:

Councillor Peter Harrison visited the MUGA recently and observed a number of concerning reports.

- (i) The welded mesh fence is sitting proud of the MUGA surface in excess of the diameter of a tennis ball. (The MUGA is designed to also be used as a tennis court). It has been reported that tennis balls are running underneath the fence.
- (ii) There is now excessive weed growth along the edges and rear (beck end). Numerous blisters are causing a safety risk.

The clerk will write to the administrator and contractor about the defects and report to the council.
